Annual Mass of Remembrance for all our Loved Ones who died since last November Saturday 4th November at 5.00 pm

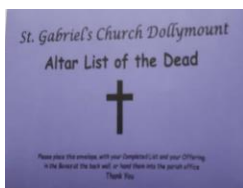
