One is on the outside wall of the **Parish Centre**, facing the carpark. It is in a locked cabinet which keeps it at an even temperature and ready for use. The code to open the cabinet is printed on it, but also easy to remember - St. Patrick's Day, **1703**.

The second one is in the **Church**, as you enter the main door it is in the middle porch on your right. This is in a smaller cabinet and the door just pulls open. An alarm will sound it will stop as soon as the door is closed again.

Check out both of them and remember where they are - you could save someone's life!
