A derelict statue has been beautifully restored by one of our Community Employment men, Brendan Burke. Suggestions of where to place it have led to a proposed siting on the side of the Church facing Dollymount Park.

We have asked an architect to draw up plans and they are displayed on the noticeboards inside the Church. Anyone who has seen them is very much in favour and I hope they meet your approval.

Our placing of seats in the church grounds in front of the Church has brought new life to the area with young families especially using them. I am grateful to those who sponsored the seats.
