Reflection in Today's Readings Do Not Be Afraid

Storms of life - which of us hasn't had them?

About exams and jobs, in marriage and friendships, and our fears of things going wrong.

What sort of fear does God calm?

The fear of being rejected by people close to us or the fear of love being lost.

Or of losing God - Like when Jesus was asleep in the boat.
