The pastoral team held its January meeting last Wednesday and had a lively discussion on several topics.

This year marks the **60th anniversary** of St. Gabriel's Church and an exciting list of possible events to mark the occasion was identified. Lots more information later.

The **Cluster group** for our three parishes organised the Bridge Magazine at Christmas, the Penitential services at Christmas and Easter and other such events covering all three Parishes. They are now planning a series of talks in Manresa during Lent – more details nearer the time.

Our **Refugee Fund** has received donations of €10,000 for which we are very grateful. We will shortly bring you full details of the fund and how it is proposed to use it.

Our **Befriending Service** is also going very well. All of our volunteers are engaged in visitation, some in St. Joseph's Hospital in Raheny and one volunteer is reading regularly to a blind person. The rest are visiting people locally who are living alone.
