Our thanks to the parents who organised Masses throughout the year.


A tree will be planted in the grounds after the Mass in commemoration of their special day, and there will be refreshments in the parish centre after Mass. Hope you can join us!


To support the hosting of the event a national church collection will replace the Share collection this weekend. There will be similar collections in 2017 and 2018.
