MISSION SUNDAY

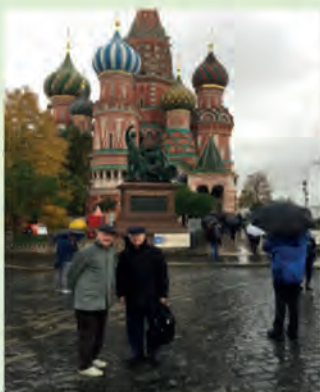
Our Annual Mission Sunday Mass is a reminder to us of the challenge of the Gospel to reach out to those in need in the Third World.

When you meet with people of other religious and cultural traditions, it challenges you to reassess your own preconceived notions and prejudices.

I realised how little I know about the Russian Orthodox Church and how much we have in common. As one priest put it "Most of our knowledge and understanding of Russia and the Orthodox Church comes from watching the movie Dr Zhivago"
