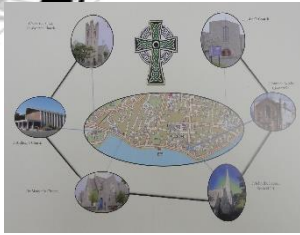


ST. GABRIEL'S NOTES

Start with a visit to Clontarf and Scots Presbyterian Church, just past the railway bridge on the Clontarf Road, and collect your passport (already stamped).

This will be stamped as you visit each of the other five churches - St. Anthony's; Clontarf Methodist; St. John the Baptist Seafield Road; St. John's Clontarf Road, and finally St. Gabriel's.
