World Meeting of Families 21st – 26th August 2018

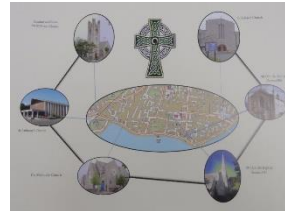
Thousands of volunteers will be an essential part of the success of this great event to be held in Dublin next year.
