Emergency Appeal for East Africa

Dear Father

At the June Bishop's Conference we heard directly from
Éamonn Meehan from Trócaire of the appalling situation
facing the people of East Africa, which has now reached a
critical stage.

There are severe food shortages in South Sudan, Somalia,
Kenya and Ethiopia brought about by drought and
conflict. Over half the population of Somalia (6.2 million
people) is experiencing food shortages and
malnutrition. There have also been major outbreaks of cholera
across the country. South Sudan is on the brink of famine,
with drought and conflict affecting millions. Millions of people
in south-eastern Ethiopia and northern Kenya are in urgent
need of humanitarian assistance. On behalf of Irish Catholics,
Trócaire is doing all it possible can - currently helping over
150,000 people across the region with emergency food, water
and sanitation.

The need is enormous and the Bishops' Conference is
responding by launching an emergency Church Appeal
throughout Ireland to take place on;

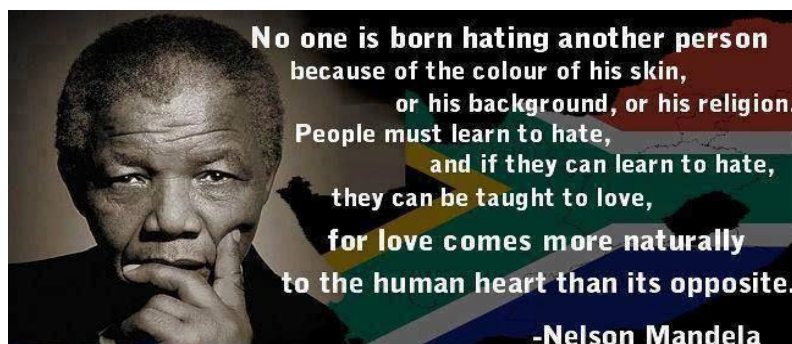
Next Saturday 22nd & Sunday 23rd July
