We hope you like our two new Shrines, with grateful thanks to Sean McKeon who took on the task of replacing two Confession Boxes with the shrines and did a beautiful job!



Work on the church's windows in Saint John the Baptist church

It has been brought to our attention that some of the church windows, including the stained-glass windows in the sanctuary, are in urgent need of repair, especially the outside surrounds and tracery. The deterioration is quite visible

looking up from the outside at the windows facing Vernon Avenue direction. The stained-glass windows in the sanctuary are of a very high quality. The work of cleaning, repairing and restoring is highly specialized, requiring professional expertise. Work began on two selected windows last month. When this work is completed, we will have a better idea of the total cost, which is likely to be significant. This will be a phased project in several stages over a number of years.



The Summer Pilgrimage Walk on the Camino in Spain.



The three Clontarf parishes joined with the students of UCD to take on a pilgrimage walk in aid of the work of Fr Peter McVerry over twelve days in May/June. We had six students from UCD and six parishioners from the Clontarf and Dollymount areas and the way both younger and older members joined together was something that will stay with us for a long time. As one of our walkers remarked, "Our daily quest for a roof over our heads, food and a clean bed helped me appreciate the little things in life that are stacked in my favour and which often go unnoticed by me". We thank all those who made the Camino walk possible and if it looks like a possibility for summer 2018 we will let you know well in advance.

Battle, War and Peace

Because of the importance of peace and the continual challenge to it around the world from conflict, war and terrorism, the Church of Ireland and Roman Catholic parishes of St John the Baptist in Clontarf are organising a number of major Peace Events over the next few years. These will be built around music and poetry and anchored in scripture readings on peace and reconciliation. The first of these is at 8.00 pm on Friday, 29th September in St John the Baptist church, Clontarf Rd and at 8.00 pm on Saturday 30th September in St John the Baptist church, Seafield Rd. The Brass Quintet of the Royal Norwegian Navy Band are returning to contribute to this event. A representative of the Irish Defence Forces will read poetry, in solidarity with those who died in battle. The internationally renowned classical guitarist, John Feeley, will play several pieces including one of his famous Bach arrangements. Aimee Farrell Courtney, the most important Bodhrán player of her generation, will also play at the event. To mark these events and the importance of peace, a Peace Tree is being planted near the Red Stables, in St Anne's Park, Clontarf at 11.00am on Friday 29 September 2017.


