Thursday 1st February: Feast of St. Brigid.

According to legend, Brigid asked the King of Leinster for land to build a monastery. When he refused Brigid and her sisters went and prayed that he would change his mind.

She returned again and this time requested that he give her as much land as her cloak would cover.

He laughed at the idea but when she spread out her cloak it began to grow and covered many acres.

The king realised that she was truly blessed by God and helped her with land, money & food. He later converted to Christianity and Brigid built her monastery on that land around the year 470AD

Saturday 3rd February Feast of St. Blaise
