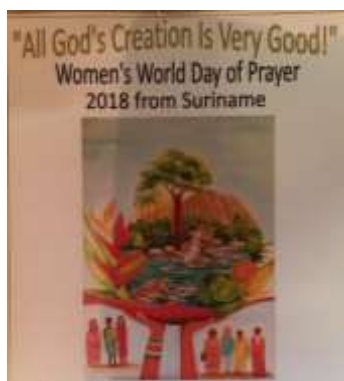




Divine Mercy Sunday
