Parish Maintenance

Boxes of envelopes for the coming year are this week being distributed to all of you who very kindly continue to contribute to our Parish Maintenance Fund by weekly or monthly envelope. and for which we are very grateful.

Your donations to the Parish Maintenance Fund help provide all our Altar requirements - hosts, wine, candles, flowers, etc. and help pay for light, heat, insurance, wages and all our day to day expenses.

You may be aware that the two collections at Mass and your Christmas and Easter Dues are all sent in full to the Diocese. The First Collection and dues are used to pay our priests and those who are retired, ill, or working in poorer parishes.

The **Share Collection** is used to finance evangelical projects in the diocese such as Teen Hope, which is currently training leaders to launch a project for our youth later this year. It also assists poorer parishes.
