



One-Day Volunteer Roles are now available at the Papal Mass on Sunday 26th Aug. as:

Papal Mass Stewards
Holy Communion Team

Anyone over the age of 18 can volunteer as a **Papal Mass Steward**. Under current legislation, Garda vetting is not required, Training will be provided and you will receive a uniform to identify your role. Stewards will work in two-hour shifts, providing directional support to the 600,000 people coming into the Park and again when they are leaving.

Ministers of the Eucharist must be already trained and serving as Ministers of the Eucharist in their own Parish. They also need to be steady on their feet as they may be serving in grassy areas. Garda vetting will be required, unless you already vetted for WMOF.

The Stats: The Redemptoristine Sisters in Drumcondra and the Cistercian Sisters in Glencairn have kindly provided over half a million hosts for the day. They have 4,500 newly made ciboria, and they will need about 4,000 Ministers of the Eucharist,
