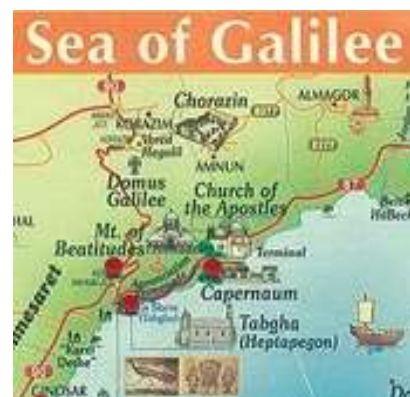
Tabgha
