Look what's Happened to your old Glasses!

A team of two optomistrists, Dr. Kanak and Dr. David, along with their assistants, last week visited Padwot



Mvura, a remote village outside Kampala, Uganda, to test the residents' eyesight and distribute the huge number of glasses donated by you. Dr. Kanak had already examined and graded all the glasses.

This happy man is Godwin, the first to receive his new glasses.

The team tested the eyesight of 456 villagers, none of whom had ever had this done before. 159 needed glasses, 7 needed cataract operations and 3 needed eye medication. the district Health Officer came from Kampala to see the project and agreed to fund the catatact operations He also had his eyes tested for the first time - and needed glasses.

The team will continue to travel to other remote villages and distribute all the glasses as needed.
