Good Shepherd Sunday

Today is *Good Shepherd Sunday*, when we reflect on the importance of the ministerial priesthood and on prayer for vocations to the priesthood.

In his message for the World day of Prayer for Vocations Pope Francis says that there can be no greater joy than to risk one's life for the Lord! He encourages us, especially the young, not to be deaf to the Lord's call:

"If he calls you to follow his path, do not pull your oars into the boat, but trust him. Do not yield to fear, which paralyses us before the great heights to which the Lord points us."

In previous years we would also have had a special collection for seminarians today, but with the fall in numbers this has now been replaced with a new annual collection called the Ministry Collection, which will be held next weekend. This new collection will be devoted to building up new forms of lay ministry in our parishes. The work of spreading the Gospel of Jesus in our changing religious culture will require more lay people working in various ways alongside our priests at the heart of parish communities.
