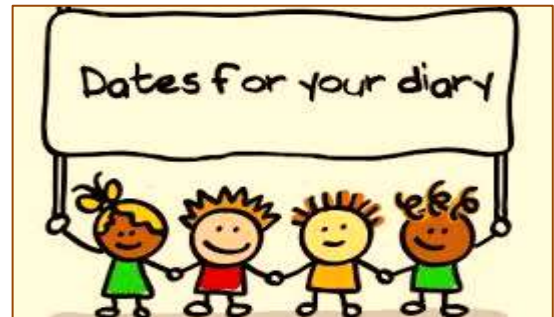
Please Take Care of Our Church Grounds
