Tridium in honour of St Maximilian Kolbe

Fairview parish will hold a three-day Tridium in honour of St. Maximilian Kolbe, O.F.M. Conv. in the Church of the Visitation, Fairview from Monday 12th - Wednesday 14th August, the Feast day of St. Maximilian. The solemn act of consecration of Mary Immaculate and the Blessing of the relic of St. Maximilian will take place each day at the end of the 10.00am Mass. All most welcome.

Maximilian Kolbe was a priest working in Poland during WW2. In 1941 he was arrested and sent to Auschwitz. After some inmates tried to escape, twelve men were chosen to die by starvation as a warning to others. Maximilian took the place of one man who pleaded for his life as he had a young family. He prayed with and cared for each of the other men until they died peacefully, and finally was given a lethal injection and died on the 14th August 1941. He was canonised by Pope John Paul in 1982.
