Irish Cancer Needs Volunteers to Drive Patients to Hospital Appointments

Volunteer Drivers transport cancer patients to and from their chemotherapy treatments in hospitals. Volunteers can support patients through a difficult time. Patients who access the service report a sense of independence and less anxiety related to the journey to treatment.

All volunteers must participate in an interview and training session (boundaries, confidentiality, data protection, etc), agree to provide two non-familial references and to undergo garda vetting. To support drivers, the team hold Support & Supervision meetings twice a year. All volunteer recruitment, interviews, training and Support & Supervision sessions are held locally.
