A Message from our Local SVP Conference



1979 KNOCK 2019

This year marks the 140th anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady at Knock on 21st August 1879.



Several special events to mark the occasion are taking place, including the unveiling of a historic model of Knock Village as it was at the time of the apparition in 1879, offering a unique insight into the lives of those who lived there. A new processional statue of Our Lady of Knock will be blessed at the 3pm ceremony on 21st August, and at 7pm there will be a Witnesses' Walk retracing the steps of those who witnessed the apparition from the town to the parish church.

Daily seminars are held every day at 12 noon, followed by anointing of the sick at 2.30 in the Basilica
