Archbishop Dermot Farrell Introduces Summer Dues in support of our Priests

While our churches were closed due to the Covid-19 virus, the first collection at Mass, which provides an income for our priests, was reduced by 54% in the last financial year, and 2180% in the first three months of this year. Funds are now at an all-time low.

The age profile of the priest is rapidly increasing, yet the priests in our diocese continue to serve while more is being asked of fewer and fewer. The ministry and mission of our Church cannot continue without this humble, generous service.

Christmas and Easter Dues also go entirely to support our priests, and this new Summer Dues collection will be used in the same way.

I know that very many people and families have suffered loss of income, employment and changes of circumstances, and thank those who have continued to support our parishes and the clergy. If you can support this new Summer Dues collection, we will be very grateful. Your generosity will provide much needed practical and moral support for priests working quietly and effectively at the heart of every local community of faith.
