## Updates to Guidelines for Weddings, Baptisms & Funerals

The following guidelines have been issued by the Dioicese



WEDDINGS

Currently 50 guests are permitted to attend awedding ceremony and reception. From Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> August the maximum number of guests permitted to attend a wedding will increase from 50 to 100 (Current protective measures apply).

BAPTISMS

From Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> August Baptism services May proceed. However they must follow all protective measures and social gatherings afterwards should be avoided. **FUNERALS** 

The number of mourners permitted at funerals continues to be limited to 50, regardless of the size of the venue.

Attendance at wakes in private homes and at funeral homes is for family only. Related family gatherings should strictly adhere to prevailing public health advice on household mixing, including visitors to oyour home and indoor and outdoor dining.
