Crosscare Annual Collection 2021

The Annual Collection for Crosscare, the social support agency of the Archdiocese of Dublin, will be taken up at all Masses this weekend, 18th and 19th September. It will replace the usual Share collection.

Through their services for Homeless, Youth, Migrants and Refugees, Crosscare focuses on helping people and families when they need it most or when they can't find the support they need anywhere else.

In their Community Foodbanks and Cafes, they provide food parcels and nutritious meals every day. Demand for their services continues to increase as the pandemic has impacted the most vulnerable in our parishes and communities.

We have now installed two Tap & Go machines in the Gathering Area. They are easy to use, and a secure and safe way to donate without using cash.
