This Sunday marks the beginning of the annual Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) Week of Witness, a Pontifical Charity dedicated to helping Christians who are persecuted for their faith, raising awareness and praying for all who are persecuted or discriminated against because of the Christian faith.

220 Million Christians live in countries where they are directly exposed to persecution, while 413 million live in countries where religious freedom is severely violated.

At the heart of the Week of Witness is **RED WENESDAY**, when ACN invites us to stand in solidarity with and bear witness to the heroic example of those of our brothers and sisters persecuted in various parts of the world for their Christian faith - wear something red, perhaps a tie, a scarf, a jumper, or light a red candle, and especially to pray for their welfare.
